

The person signing this application hereby requests Orca Productions to reserve space for use in the show listed above. It is understood that the "SHOW TERMS AND CONDITIONS" stated below are the conditions which are accepted to herewith and those terms are agreed to thereof. **A 50% DEPOSIT IS REQUIRED, WHICH SHALL BE SENT WITH THIS APPLICATION OR CONTRACT, WILL BE RETURNED. POSTDATED CHECKS CAN BE DATED UP TO NOVEMBER 30 OF THE CURRENT YEAR.** There are other charges that may be incurred, and the signer agrees to pay all balances no later than the Sunday afternoon of the show. This application is subject to cancellation, for any reason, as Orca Productions management reserves the right to reject any application. All displays are subject to final approval by the management.

SHOW TERMS AND CONDITIONS

SPACE: The space contracted for is solely for the use of the exhibitor whose name appears on the reverse side, and it is agreed that the exhibitor will not sublet or assign any portion of the same without written consent of Orca Productions. In the event the exhibitor fails to occupy or use his/her space or to have an exhibit completed and in place 2 hours prior to the opening of the show, he/she forfeits his rights to the space and also prepaid rentals, and upon demand will pay any balance owed to Orca Productions. It is understood and mutually agreed that no oral modification of this contract in any way changes the terms and conditions of this agreement. It is understood that Orca Productions will make an effort to assign the exhibitor the particular space he/she requested. But Orca Productions has the right to make the final assignment at its own discretion and to alter the location if and as necessary, in order to create a more effective exposition.

CANCELLATION POLICY: If an exhibitor cancels his contract within 30 days of the event, the full amount of the contract will be due and the exhibitor agrees to pay remaining amount of contract to Orca Productions unless the space can be resold. There will be no refunds.

LIABILITIES: The exhibitor is entirely responsible for the space leased by him/her and shall not injure, mar or deface the premises, and the exhibitor shall not drive nor allow to permit to be driven any nails, hooks, tacks, screws, etc. in any part of the facility's or decorator's equipment. Furthermore, exhibitors shall not attach to the wall any advertisement, signs, etc. by the use of tape or any other adhesive type materials on painted surfaces. The exhibitor agrees to reimburse Orca Productions and/or the exposition facility for damage or loss of the premises or the equipment to either occurring by the exhibitor leasing space in this exposition.

RESTRICTIONS: Orca Productions reserves the right to restrict or remove exhibits without refund if they have been falsely entered or may be deemed by Orca Productions as unsuitable or objectionable. This restriction applies to anything of the character that might be objectionable to the nature of the show or Orca Productions. **No SALE or DISCOUNT Signs allowed.**

BEHAVIOR: Exhibitor will be courteous and considerate to the other exhibitors. When setting up and tearing down, exhibitor will not block the entrance with his/her vehicle. Merchandise and displays will be removed from the aisles in a timely manner so as not to impede the progress of others. Exhibitor will unload in a timely manner and will not build his/her booth as he/she unloads. Exhibitor will also load up in a timely manner and will not tear down his/her booth as he/she loads.

ANIMALS: Only certified service animals will be allowed in the buildings. Certification must be shown upon request of Orca Productions staff.

INSURANCE AND LIABILITY: Neither Orca Productions nor the exposition center shall be responsible for damage or loss incurred by the exhibitor by any cause whatsoever. The exhibitor agrees to protect and save harmless, Orca Productions and the exposition center against any and all claims of loss, injury, or damage to persons or property arising from the activities of the exhibitor, his/her agents, employees or guests, defend Orca Productions and the exposition center against any and all such claims to reimburse and indemnify Orca Productions and the exposition center for any loss, damage, expense, or payment suffered thereby. Each exhibitor is responsible for liability insurance for their space and inventory. Exhibitor can contact ACNA dealer insurance or one of their choosing.

RIGHTS OF THE MANAGEMENT: Orca Productions shall not be liable for damages or other expenses that are incurred by the exhibitor in any event that the show is delayed, interrupted, or not held as scheduled for any reason whatsoever and if for any reason beyond the control of Orca Productions the show is not held, Orca Productions may retain so much of the money paid by the exhibitor as is necessary to pay expenses already incurred by Orca Productions.

AISLES: Aisles, passageways and overhead spaces remain strictly in the control of Orca Productions, and no signs, decorations, banners, advertising materials or special exhibits will be permitted in them except by special written permission of Orca Productions. All exhibits and personnel must remain in their own confines of their booth spaces and no exhibitor will be allowed to erect signs or display products in such a manner as to obstruct the view or disadvantageously affect the display of any other exhibitor.

LICENSES: Any and all licenses, city, county, state or federal, inspections or permits required by law of any exhibitor in the installation or operations of his/her display shall be the sole responsibility of obtaining by the exhibitor at his/her own expense prior to the opening of the show. Said license information must be provided to Orca Productions prior to set up.

RUNNING OF ENGINES: Oil, gas or diesel engines may be operated only with the written consent of Orca Productions and must conform to all local ordinances and regulations of the fire marshal.

FIRE: All exhibits must comply with city or county ordinances of the local fire marshal. For any information regarding this portion of the contract contact the fire marshal's office. Only 3-prong, UL Listed cords may be used. Only fire retardant table covers are allowed.

FOOD SALES: No sales or gifts of food and beverages for consumption in the facility where the show is held may be made without written permission of Orca Productions.

MERCHANDISE REMOVAL: No exhibits or part of the exhibit may be removed until after the closing hours of the last day of the show. Upon the close of an event, all exhibitors shall remove all small and valuable items from their displays. All merchandise and display materials must be removed from the building by the times given in the show brochure. Early pack out by exhibitor will terminate any further shows with promoter.

LITIGATION: If a suit or action is filed regarding this contract, the exhibitor promises to pay Orca Productions costs and reasonable attorney fees in such manner as set by the court.

NO IVORY or MIGRATORY ANIMALS or ANIMAL PARTS can be sold or displayed in any Orca Productions Show. "Tis against the law folks"
